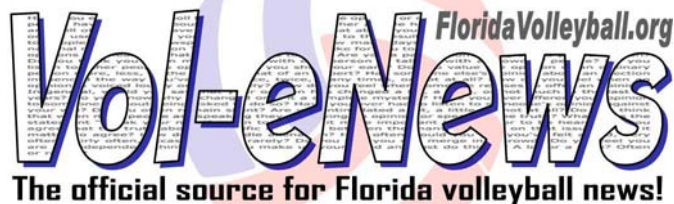
WELCOME NOTE FROM THE COMMISSIONER

CLUB HIGHLIGHT – WILDFIRE VOLLEYBALL CLUB

Each month a member club is featured in **Vol-eNews**. This is a great way to get to know the Club Director(s) and learn more about the clubs throughout Florida. This month **Ore Pablos** and **Wildfire Volleyball Club** will be highlighted.

Q: Tell us how you got started in volleyball?

A: I grew up in Cuba where volleyball is one of the more popular sports. I got involved in the sport at the age of 6.

Q: How long have you been coaching volleyball?

A: I have been Coaching volleyball for the last 20 years. I have held head coaching positions at middle schools, High Schools and Club.

Q: What are all the job titles you currently hold? How do you manage all of those responsibilities?

A: I am the Director of Wildfire Volleyball Club and the Head Coach for 16's Elite Wildfire Volleyball.

At Wildfire we have managed to put together a very energetic and productive staff that makes my job very enjoyable. We offer education, not only for the athletes, but also for the parents. Building a sense of community has helped make my job a lot easier.

Q: What would you consider to be your biggest accomplishments in volleyball?

PREMIER VOLLEYBALL LEAGUE – TEAM FLORIDA WAVE

The excitement and energy ran high as 47 female athletes showed up in hopes of securing a spot on the first semi-pro women’s team in Florida history. The Florida Region held the first Team Florida Wave tryout on Friday, December 9th at the Orlando Sports Center.



Under the leadership of head coach Nick Cheronis and assistant coach Steve Benson, a total of 24 athletes were invited to attend the first practice on Jan 8 with 13 of those athletes being paid to attend.

Team Florida Wave will compete in 3 tournaments around the state of Florida (1 possibly in Puerto Rico) before traveling to Salt Lake City, UT to compete in the league championships.

NEW USAV LIBERO RULE

ATTENTION COACHES AND/OR CLUB DIRECTORS

Please note that ALL Libero designations this season are FOR THE ENTIRE MATCH. This means that whether you indicate No Libero, One Libero, or Two Liberos on your 1st Set Line-Up Sheet, that stays in affect for the entire match (except as provided for under Rule 19.4 "Re-Designation of a New Libero").

Please also bear in mind that any player designated as a Libero (either starting Libero or secondary Libero) for the 1st set of a match becomes **INELIGIBLE** to play in any subsequent sets as a **REGULAR** player in that match (except as provided for under Exceptional Substitution Rule USAV 15.7a, which states that a Libero can be used as an exceptional sub as a very last resort).
