PHIL DALHAUSSER



Since his 2003 debut, Phil Dalhausser has become one of the most decorated and successful players in beach volleyball history. His awards are too numerous to name, but they include Blocking, Serving, Offense, Setting, Most Outstanding, MVP – basically everything besides digging. Phil won the Gold Medal at the Beijing Olympics in 2008 with partner Todd Rodgers, and Phil was also named tournament MVP. The duo came back for the 2012 London Olympics and took 9th. Phil is both starting and ending his career with longtime pal Nick Lucena. The team took a 5th at the Rio 2016 Olympics and is on track to compete in the Tokyo Olympics.

Ricardo Alex Costa Santos, better known as “Block Machine,” won the Silver Medal with his partner Zé Marco at the Sydney 2000 Olympic Games. In 2002, he formed the most victorious team in the world with Emanuel. They won the World Cup in 2003 in Rio de Janeiro, got the Gold Medal at the 2004 Athens Olympics, and he completed the Olympic trifecta with a Bronze Medal at the 2008 Beijing Games. His other awards are absolutely too numerous to list; he’s one of the best players to play the game with 56 Gold Medals, 30 Silver, and 24 Bronze Medals on the FIVB World Tour. Together with Emanuel, they are the only athletes to have 3 Olympic medals in the history of Beach Volleyball.



CHAIM SCHALK



Chaim Schalk is a Canadian-American Olympian who earned ninth for Canada in Rio and now plans to represent the USA at the Olympics in the future. He has one AVP championship from Seattle 2019, and five FIVB World Tour Medals at major events. In October 2019, Chaim transitioned into a USAV Beach Athlete and made his American debut capturing a Gold Medal at the Dominican Republic NORCECA 2019.

Throughout her four-year career with the Waves, Knudsen amassed an 81-31 overall record for a .723 winning percentage.
