CLUB HIGHLIGHT – SOUTH FLORIDA VOLLEYBALL

Each month a member club is featured in *Vol-eNews*. This is a great way to get to know the Club Director(s) and learn more about the clubs throughout Florida. This month **Ann Marie Indorf** and the **South Florida Volleyball Club** will be highlighted, enjoy!



Q: Ann Marie, how did you first get involved in volleyball?

A: I was 10 years younger than my sister who was a Hall of Fame volleyball player at FSU. I also had a family of coaches; my sister coached volleyball and my brother coached football. I travelled weekend after weekend to watch my sister play for Cecile Reynaud (FSU) as I sat on the bench as a little ball girl. When I graduated high school I was lucky enough to earn a scholarship to continue to play volleyball at Clemson University.

Q: How long have you been coaching volleyball?

A: I have been coaching for 17 years now. I began a collegiate coaching career at Clemson following my graduation (92-93), then an assistant at Colorado State (93-94) and then head coach at Jacksonville University (94-99).

Q: Are you involved in any other volleyball activities besides coaching?

A: Yes, I have combined my current recreation profession and past collegiate volleyball career to begin programs at the recreation level by introducing skills clinics to the kids in local communities through our Jumpin' Juniors program. We are also embarking on a new program to bring the sport into Dade County (Miami) through Urban Volleyball. This program is to be presented to the Director of Parks and Recreation of Dade County at the end of the month. This is a program to introduce the skills of volleyball to the underprivileged communities that can't afford the tradition club volleyball.

Q: When did you start your club? How many teams were in your first year? How many now?

A: It's a funny story actually. In 2002, Cookie Stevens, the former head coach at FIU and now the assistant at USC, handed me a box and the director's position in a parking lot. During my first year we had 4-6 teams and we now have 14.



Q: What would you consider to be your club's biggest accomplishment?

A: Our biggest accomplishment is the quality of coaches we have on staff, our dedication to grassroots and the retention of players year after year. I believe the collegiate players and high school coaches not only provide an amazing training ground for players but it allows collegiate players an opportunity to be better players as they give back to the sport that has given them so much. It's the passion of our staff that retains players year after year and has allowed our club to grow.

Q: Do you have a beach volleyball program? Explain.

A: We will be launching our beach piece this summer. **Olaya Pazo**, a former player at Rice University and current AVP player, will be a great asset to start our beach clinics in order to prepare for the Dig The Beach series coming in May. We will partner with Club Beach Dig and help promote beach volleyball in our area.

Q: What are your future plans with your club team?

A: Our future plans are to restructure next season to able to provide a better training ground. Now that we have built on the grassroots and have grown in participation we now want to make our club the most competitive in the Florida Region. A training facility is on our radar and could be a possibility for next season. "Build it and they will come" I have learned from my mentors Mary Andrew (JJVA) and Yvonne Devlin (OVA).

Q: Does your club do anything to promote youth volleyball (11 and under)?

A: Yes, we promote youth volleyball through Jumpin Jr's. We organize clinics at recreation facilities all over, to introduce skill development in young players for both boys and girls. Just recently we had an open clinic for a small community called Key Biscayne in which over 100 kids participated in. The kids had a great time learning the sport of volleyball. Q: What do you look forward to in the future for the Florida Region?

A: The Florida Region has grown tremendously and our leadership has been outstanding with people we have on staff in our Florida Region. It's not just a job, They CARE!!!! I am looking forward to more of our Florida teams making an impact at the National level and more of our players competing for the National Team in the future. We need to encourage our former players to coach not only at the club level but in the school systems.

The Ranking Committee meets monthly to review the standings. **IMPORTANT:** Clubs that wish to challenge the rankings prior to the Regional Bid Championships and the Regional Volleyball Championships may submit a formal challenge with the head-to-head results of the team(s) they are challenging.
