

Club Director MMS Process - 2022-23 USAV Season

Check with your region for specific policies and requirements in your area.


Club directors will need to complete these administrative steps in order to participate as a USA Volleyball club in their Region this season:

- 1. Ensure Region requirements for affiliation are complete
- 2. Gain access to your club's SportsEngine HQ
- 3. Facilitate membership purchase and club assignment for all club team participants
- 4. Ensure all participants complete their membership eligibility requirements
- 5. Create eligible rosters for your teams


Region Affiliation and Club HQ Access


Returning clubs

- 1. Complete all requirements from your Region for your club to be in good standing for the new season.
- 2. Check your access to your club HQ.
 - <u>Login to your SportsEngine Account</u>: Prevent duplicate accounts by using the same email address that you used to manage your club last season
 - Your club should appear in the "My Organizations" menu of your account
- 3. Check your USA Volleyball Tab access.



- If you do not see the USA Volleyball tab in your HQ, reach out to your Region office for next steps
- 4. <u>Assign/Remove</u> access to other administrators for your club as appropriate.
- 5. Complete USAV Administrative Eligibility Requirements.
 - You can access your club's HQ at any time on SportsEngine once you are an administrator. However, you
 can only access the USA Volleyball area of the HQ if you are in good standing with your Region and
 you've met all administrator requirements.





New clubs

- 1. Complete all requirements from your Region for a new club to be in good standing for the new season.
- 2. Contact your Region to have a HQ created for your club. This may take a few business days to complete.
- 3. Complete steps 2-5 above as needed.


Membership Purchase & Club Assignment

Tryout and membership assignment policies differ by Region, please be familiar with your Region's policies and procedures before taking any of the steps below.


Athletes and staff need a valid Region membership affiliated with your club in order to be rostered and participate. Once you know which staff and athletes will be participating with your club this season and your Region has opened its memberships for purchase, send the public club assignment link to those participants. This will allow your participants to purchase a membership in your Region and be assigned to your club in a single process.

Send Your Club Assignment Link

- 1. From the left navigation menu of your SportsEngine HQ, click USA Volleyball > Memberships.
- On the Memberships page, click "generate an open link" under Public Club Assignment.




- 3. A link is generated that can be copied and shared to your participants through email or your messaging tool
- 4. The system determines the appropriate Region membership based on their profile and the data provided.



Membership Eligibility

Members must complete eligibility requirements before they can participate. These requirements depend on the membership and roster role and could include: participation waivers, SafeSport Training, background check and IMPACT Training


Once your participants purchase their membership, they may still have eligibility requirements to complete. You can <u>REMIND</u> your club's coaches and athletes about requirements through HQ at any time. Eligibility requirements can be accessed through a member's SPORTSENGINE ACCOUNT.

Additional Requirements

Your region may have additional training that is required for coaches/athletes (examples: referee/scorekeeper/line judge training). These requirements do not affect an individual's eligibility status but may be required for a roster. These types of training are completed in the USAV Academy.



Rostering

Team rosters can be built in the Governing Season area of your SportsEngine HQ to ensure they meet USA Volleyball/Region requirements.

- 1. Build rosters under the Governing Seasons tab.
 - If your club pays for other SportsEngine tools, you will use the SE Sync method.
 - If your club does not pay for premium tools you can build your rosters manually or using a CSV file upload.
 - USA Volleyball does not recommend the "copy teams" functionality unless the age group and members of the team will remain the same.
- 2. Members should display as approved on the roster if:
 - They have the correct Region membership for the roster role (coach, athlete, manager, etc)
 - Their membership is eligible and assigned to your club
 - o They meet Region age requirements for the team position
 - They are assigned to only one team
- 3. If all members placed on a team roster are approve for the team, the team roster status will show "done".



Rostering Notes:

- Your Region may have additional requirements for staff and players on the roster (examples: officiating/scorekeeping/line judge training). Check the credentials on your printed roster to ensure compliance with Region policy.
- You may need to transfer or build your roster in other event systems to enter some USA Volleyball events (AES, TM2Sign, SportWrench, etc.)
