OFFICIAL VS. UNOFFICIAL VISITS

If the college pays for the trip or reimburses you the costs of the trip then it is considered an official visit. However if the athlete pays for the visit then it is an unofficial visit.

RULES OF OFFICIAL VISITS

NCAA D I

- An athlete is limited to a total of 5 official visits to Division 1 colleges
- You may start going on official visits on September 1st of your junior year in high school
- An official visit will last a maximum of 48 hours

NCAA D III

- An athlete may go on an unlimited number of official visits to Division 3 colleges
- You may start going on official visits on January 1st of your junior year in high school
- An official visit will last a maximum of 48 hours

NAIA

- An athlete may go on an unlimited number of official visits to Division 3 colleges
- The NAIA does not have a time frame for when you can begin going on official visits.
- An official visit will last a maximum of 48 hours

NCAA D II

- An athlete may go on an unlimited number of official visits to Division 2 colleges
- You may start going on official visits on June 15th before your junior year in high school
- An official visit will last a maximum of 48 hours

NJCAA (2 YEAR COLLEGES)

- An athlete may go on an unlimited number of official visits to NJCAA colleges
- You may start going on official visits after your junior year in high school
- An official visit will last a maximum of 48 hours

NOTE: YOU CAN TAKE AS MANY UNOFFICIAL VISITS AS YOU WOULD LIKE. THOUGH FOR DIVISION 1 SCHOOLS YOU MAY NOT GO ON AN UNOFFICIAL VISIT UNTIL SEPTEMBER 1ST OF YOUR JUNIOR YEAR.
