We rolled into July with over 60 of our Florida Region teams competing in the 2014 USAV Junior National Championships. The boy's teams competed in Houston, TX and the girls teams competed in Minneapolis, MN. Several of our girl's teams did quite well in the tournament and were crowned as National Champions! You will be able to find a full recount of the winning teams in this edition of Vol-eNews.

Several of our men's Florida WAVE professional athletes were selected to participate in the first annual PVL All-Star Exhibition matches, which took place at the Boys' Jr. National Championships in Houston:

- **Kyle Friend**, Outside Hitter

Athletes were selected based on their team's finish at the PVL Championships in Phoenix, AZ. The Florida WAVE men's team finished 5th.

Our biggest event yet this summer was the grand opening of our new Hickory Point Beach Sand Volleyball Complex in Tavares, FL (Northwest of Orlando) on Saturday, July 5th. This 21-court state-of-the-art sand volleyball complex has been in the planning stages for a long time and through a unique partnership between the Florida Region, the Lake County Water Authority, and Lake County government, it has officially opened. The grand opening was a great success and we are excited for what the future holds. We hope that you will make plans to join us at the largest sand volleyball complex in Florida! COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

It has been a busy year for everyone as our sport continues to grow and more events fill the calendar. As your commissioner, I have attempted to attend as many events as possible to represent your interests and ensure the quality of playing and educational opportunities for our members. I have attended the following events as commissioner this year: Girls Bid Tournament, Girls Regional Tournament, Lake County Commissioners meeting for the Hickory Point Beach Vote, Boys Regionals, Board Meetings at Region Office, Meetings with Executive Director and Staff at Region Office, and RVA meetings in Phoenix, Arizona.

The Regional Volleyball Association (RVA) meetings consist of all 40 Regional Commissioners/Executive Directors from the nation meeting together with the USA Volleyball staff twice a year. The most recent meeting was held in Phoenix, the site of the US Open Adult Championships. The following items were discussed and some will actually be in place for the next competitive season:

1. JNQ directors need to limit play schedules at NQ's so teams are not in the gym all day playing more than four matches in one day
2. The 18U Championships will move to earlier in the season in 2016
3. Enforce transfer rules between regions to stop the creation of cross region All-Star Teams
4. The new ball may be adopted at the same time the NCAA adopts it
5. Requested American bids not used to flow back to the regions
6. Expand 13U Open to 32 teams at the National Championships
7. Expand National Division to 64 teams at the National Championships
8. A new Board of Directors position was added for a Sitting Volleyball Representative.
9. The Adult R2 required in 14U and below divisions at national qualifying events must now be a trained (in R2 and scorekeeping) adult with a USAV membership with a background screen (does not have to be on the roster)
10. The national officiating staff is working hard to simplify and increase the efficiency of the Learning Management System (LMS) for the officiating training required for work teams. There will be a brief pre-test to pre-qualify those who already have a working knowledge of the rules and procedures. There will be fewer modules and less time expended for those who pass the pre-test.
11. Lori Okimura was voted the Chair of the USA Volleyball Board of Directors – first woman to hold this position.
12. All players listed on the roster of a team that is qualified for the GJNC may not be on the roster of or play on any other team attempting to qualify for the GJNC. This rule applies regardless of whether the qualifying attempt is in a Qualifier, at a regional event that determines which team(s) is awarded the region's Club bid(s), or through an at-large process. This includes a team in the same club.

We will continue to grow boys' volleyball through the efforts of the coaches and directors in each district who have committed themselves to the boys division. If you need help with growing boys in your area, please call Rob Holley, Russel Williams or Steve Benson (Men's coach at Warner) for assistance. In their annual meeting the boys directors came up with some great ideas for promoting the boys game, so give these guys a call if you wish to grow boys in your club or area. Some of the ideas include, establishing a set season schedule of tournaments, have an early season tournament in the Miami area, use more 1-day tournament formats, sanction only one tournament per day or weekend, move boys HP to different time, plan exhibitions by the Florida Wave players and or college men's teams, host clinics in local area middle and elementary schools, have older youth teams doing exhibitions at elementary and middle schools, Region directory of staff and coaches available to do boys clinics.

Beach/Sand volleyball continues to grow and may become a sanctioned sport in 2016 as 40 colleges now have teams. Look for more growth and changes in NCAA Sand Volleyball.

The NVL & Rox Beach Series Tour is hosting many events in our region and throughout the nation – players can win points to move on to the National Championships in Port St. Lucie, FL. Two tour stops in Florida have already been held with great success and fun for all of the players.

USA Volleyball and the United States Olympic Committee launched an important project last year titled "Safe Sport". Much time and energy was spent on this topic at the recent RVA meetings as the USOC has mandated every governing body in the nation to have a Safe Sport Program. All of us should be concerned and watchful for the safety and well-being of our players, coaches and parents. Of particular interest is the safety and well-being of our youth players. The information on child abuse is prolific and available, but many times in youth sports no one wants to talk about it, as they feel it can never happen in their life, their team, their club or their area. Once you have been shown the research and facts, it is apparent how terrible and misguided is such an attitude. More information and training will be presented in the near future concerning our responsibilities to keep our training and playing environments safe for our children and other members. This is an important responsibility for the leadership of all of our clubs and event directors.

Coming Soon – Sitting Volleyball! In the fall I will be attempting to host several clinics for sitting volleyball around the state. This sport can be played by anyone, but the disabled in our communities can benefit greatly from this sport. We will be enlisting the aid of the Veterans groups and rehab centers in our region. If you are interested in hosting a clinic for sitting volleyball in your area – give me a call.

NEW CLUB RULES FOR THE 2014 – 2015 SEASON...

1. Tryouts may take place at any time of the year for youth and junior athletes.
2. Athletes may officially select and commit to a USAV club in Florida beginning on Nov 1st of each year.
3. Athletes must sign a Florida Region player commitment form on or after Nov 1st to affirm their club of choice. The form will reside with the club and must be made available within 3 business days upon request by the Florida Region. Note: Only current year player commitment forms issued by the Florida Region will be considered valid. Prior year forms will be invalid.
4. Athletes may only affiliate with one club during the indoor club season (see season definitions below).
5. All athletes renewing their USAV memberships between Sep 1 & Oct 31 will only be able to select UNDECIDED in WebPoint as their club of choice.
6. Once an athlete selects a club in WebPoint during the Indoor Club Season, they will only be able to transfer to another USAV club after obtaining a written release from the club they wish to depart. Athlete's not committed via a Florida Region player commitment form, will be transferred without the requirement of a written release. Once an athlete participates in a JNQ or qualifying event, they are no longer eligible to be transferred to and rostered with another junior volleyball club.
7. In the event that a club elects not to release an athlete, but is unable to provide proof of any of the following:
 - a. A spot on an age appropriate team with at least 6 athletes and a qualified coach
 - b. A team that is accepted into at least two USAV sanctioned tournaments
 - c. A team that holds active practices for the team

The athlete will be released without the requirement of a written release from the USAV club so that they may get the full benefits of their USAV membership. Note: Clubs must provide verifiable proof to the Florida Region office within 5 business days of the request. Note: All personal business/legal commitments made between the club and the family will remain the responsibility of the related parties. The Florida Region will not be responsible for enforcing private agreements.

Important Note: Florida Region reserves the right to release athletes after a formal review by the Jr. Admin Board.

Additionally, we need to clearly define the seasons for youth and junior female athletes in the Florida Region:

- Indoor Friendship/Mini-Club Season – Aug 1 to Oct 31
- Indoor Club Season – Nov 1 to JRC or JNC, whichever one is later for the respective athlete
- Beach Season – May 1 to Oct 31

This tryout policy for junior girls is to become effective immediately for the 2014/2015 season and for all subsequent years until updated or revised by the Florida Region Board of Directors.
