FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Breaking news...USAV Rules Commission Modified Libero Jersey Rule 19.2 to be More Flexible! Yes, you read that correctly. USAV has implemented a revision to the previous Libero jersey rule and they decided to make it effective immediately. This means that all of the early season concerns over Libero jersey compliance are now over and junior volleyball teams can eliminate that worry as they prepare for their next event. I would point out that the revised rule reads as follows: USAV Rule 19.2: The Libero(s) must wear a uniform which clearly contrasts with the rest of the team.

I would also like to point out that our Commissioner, Mary Andrew, was at that meeting representing the regions and was partly responsible for the implementation of this revision. The Regional Volleyball Association (RVA) meeting minutes clearly reflect that Mary has been a strong advocate for simplifying the uniform rules to create fewer compliance concerns for clubs. She has gone on record stating that the athletes playing volleyball are equally concerned about the "fashionability" of the uniforms they wear during the season and that rules should allow creativity and style consciousness. Mary was pleasantly surprised that the rule modification was implemented so quickly since most rule changes normally do not take effect until the next playing season. So I hope that you will join me in offering a big "Thank You" to Mary for her leadership on this issue.

There is one other important note to mention is regarding our scholarship program. The scholarship committee recently met to address the date conflict for our awards ceremony and the 1st Annual Spring Girls' Jr. National Championships for the 18u division. If you are a female high school senior, you are most likely aware of the date conflict. The decision made was to allow certain scholarships to be awarded to female athletes that could not attend due to their participation in the new 18u national championship event. So high school seniors (male & female) are encouraged to submit their applications by the Mar 25th deadline for consideration.

From the Office of the Executive Director

- To: High School Seniors in the Florida Region
- Date: February 29, 2016
- Re: Scholarship Update for 2016

I am writing this update on behalf of the Florida Region Scholarship Committee to all high school seniors that are currently members of the Florida Region of USA Volleyball.

This section is for the girls...

It has come to our attention that there is a significant date conflict between our annual awards ceremony and the new 18u Girls' Jr. National Championships in 2016. Since the inception of the scholarship awards, dating back to 2007, we have required all scholarship recipients to attend our annual event to receive their scholarship award from the individual or corporation funding the scholarship. Due to the new 18u national championship event this year we realize that, depending on the number of 18u teams that qualify, there could be a material number of female high school seniors that would not be eligible for consideration. Obviously the intent behind raising over \$11,000 in scholarships for high school seniors was not to eliminate some of our best candidates from across Florida. So the committee has unanimously decided to allow all female high school seniors attending the new 18u national championship event to be considered for a select group of scholarships that will not have a representative/presenter at the awards ceremony. This decision will prevent those select athletes from not being eligible due to the two conflicting events. I would note that female high school seniors <u>not</u> attending the new 18u national championship event will still have to attend the awards ceremony to be eligible for a scholarship award.

This section is for the boys...

The exception above for female athletes attending the new 18u national championship event does not apply to boys since there is no such conflicting event. All boys applying for a scholarship must attend the awards ceremony to be eligible for a scholarship award. With that said, I would encourage more boys to apply since we only receive a small number of applications from boys each year.

We hope that this update will clear up any concerns for 2016. Please remember to submit your completed application and accompanying documents by 5pm on Friday, Mar 25th. This year we will award \$11,500 in scholarships to some of the best and brightest high school seniors in the Florida Region!

USA VOLLEYBALL ACADEMY ONLINE TRAINING UPDATE...



Attention all junior players, coaches and parents:

ALL TECHNICAL ISSUES REQUIRE A HELP DESK TICKET – CLICK HERE TO ACCESS

The online ref training system was revised for the 2015-2016 season last month. In general the requirements will be the same as last year. Again this year will be the ability to "test out" of some modules. So, for example, if you are familiar with scoring and can successfully answer the pre-quiz offered at the beginning of the module, you will not need to continue and watch that module in its entirety. If you do not answer the pre-quiz questions successfully, you will just continue in the module and take the quiz after reviewing the content.

Junior players and rostered adults who will perform work team duties at tournaments must be trained. The rostered adults do not have to be coaches, but they must be performing one of the score table duties: Second referee, scorer, assistant scorer (also known as Libero tracker) or visual scoreboard operator (also known as "flipper.")

There are four courses available for Junior work team members:

- FL16_101 Florida Junior Work Team Line Judge
- FL16_102 Florida Junior Work Team Libero Tracker
- FL16_103 Florida Junior Work Team Scorer
- FL16_104 Florida Junior Work Team Second Referee

The coach or rostered adult who will be at the table should take all four courses. Players may take up to four. It is recommended that all players take the Line Judge (FL16_101) and Libero Tracker (FL16_102) courses. Then, at least half of the club's players should take the scoring course (FL16_103) and the other half the second referee course (FL16_104). This will give the team flexibility to provide trained workers at all their tournament matches. When working a tournament, the player performing the duty must be certified for that duty. So if a player is keeping score, they must have taken the scorer course, FL16_103. It is **not acceptable** for a scorer to teach another player who has not taken the course how to keep score at a tournament.

In order to get credit for the courses, players must register in the USA Volleyball data base system Webpoint. This is the same site you use when you register to play each season. Go to www.floridavolleyball.org and click on the "Log In" button in the middle of the home page. Then, carefully follow the instructions for registration found <u>here.</u>

Once you are registered, you actually take the courses in another system found at <u>www.usavolleyballacademy.org</u>. If you register for your courses and need to take a break before finishing, when you come back you need to sign in on this USAV Academy screen:

USA Volleyball Academy Tips

Many of the issues that users encountered last season, such as browser problems, have been eliminated by the hardware and software upgrades that took place over the summer. In case you do experience any issues, here are some of the tips we offer to users:

- Make sure your flash player is up to date.
- Make sure pop-ups are not blocked on your computer.

• Attempt to access the course material via another computer if your business computer blocks such sites.

If you sign up for a course in Webpoint and then do not see the course you need listed under My Courses in the USAV Academy, you need to send an email to sue@floridavolleyball.org. Include the player name in the email.

If you have registered for a curriculum in error (you selected the wrong clinic) you cannot fix this yourself! Please do not try to re-register for that clinic. Email sue@floridavolleyball.org for assistance. Be sure to include the player's name and team information.

If you have been asked by your coach to provide a certificate of completion and you do not receive one by email, you may print one on your own. Sign in to USAV Academy and click on the Transcripts tab in the upper left corner. Click on the Certificates button that appears at the far right. In the box that opens, click to highlight the certificate you wish to print. Your certificate will download, and you may print that pdf file.



CORA SPORTS MEDICINE TIP...

Hey volleyball fans! Here is part 2 of our series featuring exercises that correct common volleyball movement dysfunctions. These include: shoulder stability, rotational trunk stability, rotational upper back (thoracic) mobility, hamstring flexibility, shoulder posterior capsular tightness and shoulder blade (scapula) stability.

As we discussed in the last issue, a Functional Movement Screen attempts to pin point weak links and alleviate them. This system is a process that identifies the weak link in the movement pattern and then assigns exercises to correct it. Arm Lifts on Hands & Knees

Begin on your hands and knees - hands under shoulders and knees under hips

Arm lift to side – place the band under your right hand (to hold it to ground) and grasp the band with the left hand. Raise left arm out to side with your thumb up using your shoulder blade muscles. Make sure your shoulder blade doesn't "hike" towards your ear.

Arm lift diagonal – place the band under your right knee (to hold it to ground) and grasp the band with the left hand. Raise left arm midway between shoulder and head using your shoulder blade muscles. Make sure your shoulder blade doesn't "hike" towards your ear by "packing" it towards your hip pocket.

Arm lift overhead - place the band under your left knee (to hold it to ground) and grasp the band with the left hand. Raise left arm above your head using your shoulder blade muscles. Make sure your shoulder blade doesn't "hike" towards your ear by "packing" it towards your hip pocket.

Hold for 5 seconds

Perform 2 sets of 10 - progress repetitions / resistance (gradually increase your reps to fatigue.)
